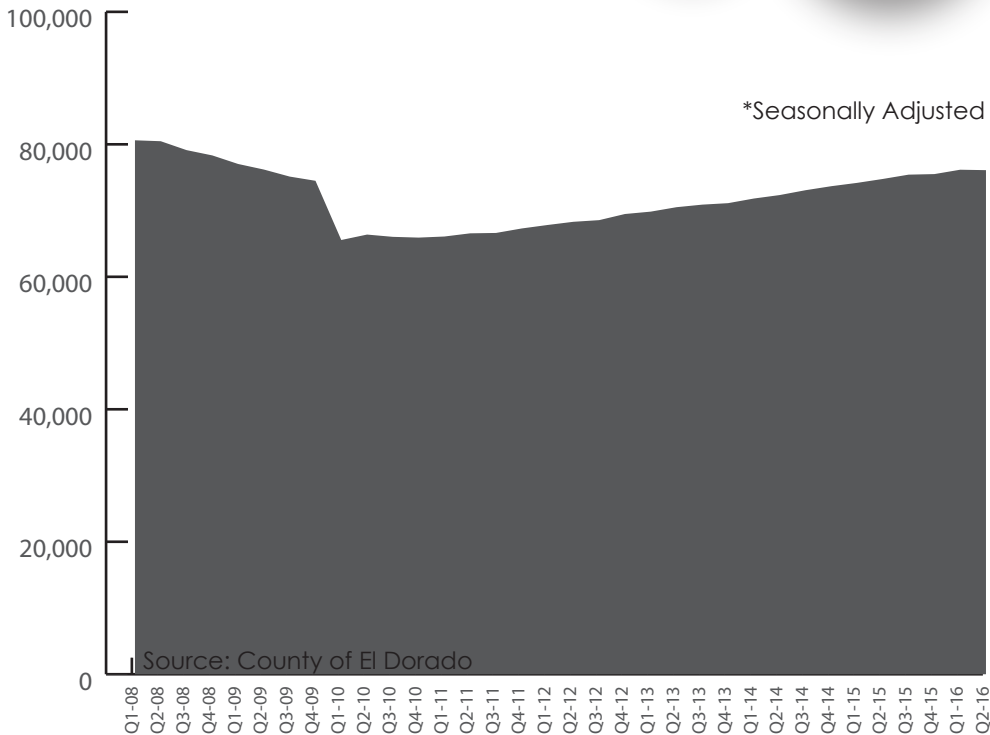

EMPLOYMENT AT A GLANCE...



There were a seasonally adjusted 76,100 residents employed in Q2 16, down 65 jobs or .1% since Q1 16.

Employment in Riverside County decreased .3% from Q1 16, with 976,600 residents employed in Q2 16.

This is first quarter since Q4 10 that the number of residents employed has decreased.

There were 16.1% more people employed in Q2 16 than our lowest point in Q1 10.

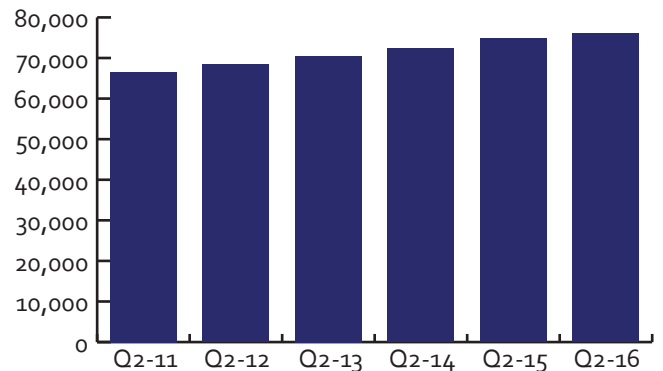
2ND QUARTER TREND

For the first time in over five years, CORONA's employment level has decreased, down just .1% from the previous quarter.

This minimal movement in employment should not be anything of great concern for CORONA. When compared to a year ago, current employment is up 1.7%. The number of residents employed is now just 4,508, or 5.6%, below CORONA's highest employment level in Q1 08.

CORONA has now recovered by 16.1% since the lowest point in Q1 10. With 10,544 more residents employed in Q2 16 versus Q1 10, the economic index for employment figures in CORONA continues to remain steady and strong.
