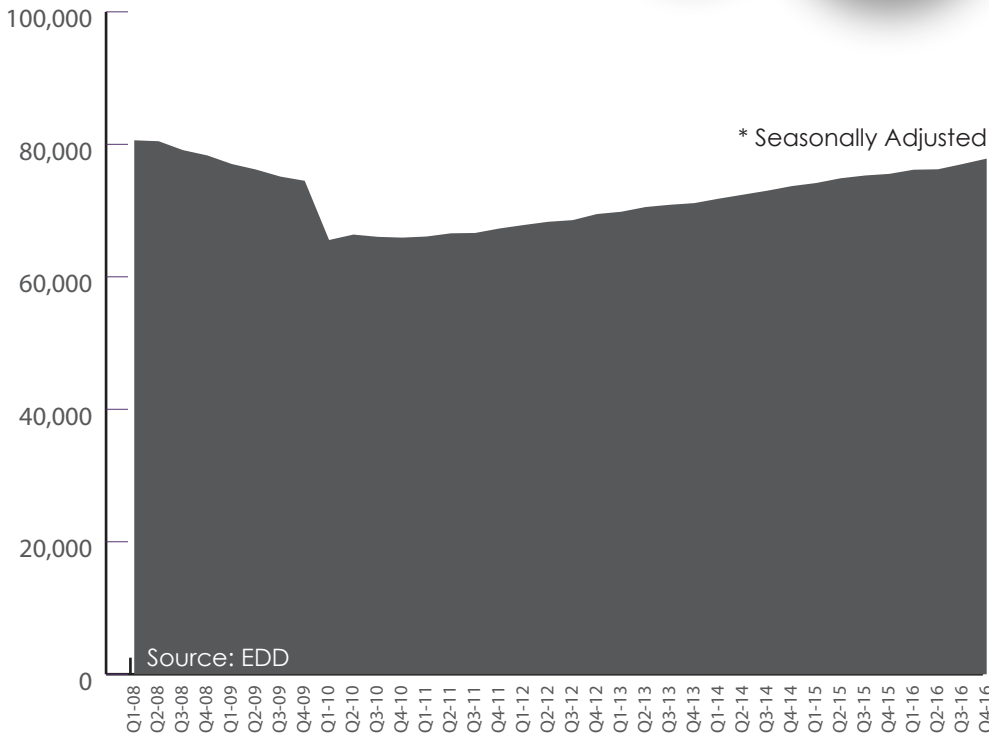

EMPLOYMENT AT A GLANCE...



There were 77,842 residents employed in Q4 16, up 826 jobs from the previous quarter.

There were 12,286 more residents employed in Q4 16 than our lowest point in Q1 10.

Employment is 3.4% or 2,766 jobs away from recovering back to our pre-recession level of Q1 08.

Fourth quarter employment has increased every year since 2011.

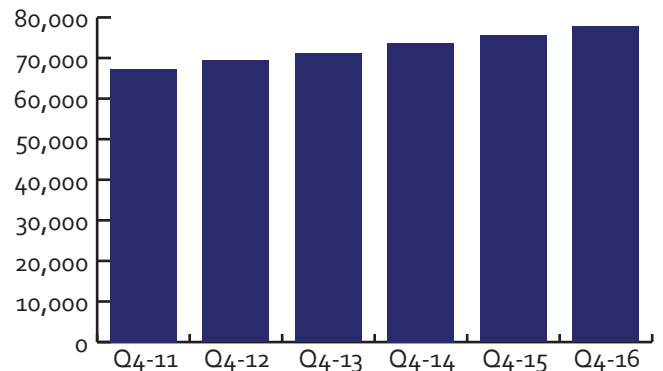
4TH QUARTER TREND

CORONA employment is up for the second quarter in a row with over 77k residents employed in Q4 16. Another 826 residents are now employed when compared to the previous quarter.

Employment has continued a steady upward trend since the recession low. When compared back to the lowest point in Q1 10, there are now over 12k more residents employed. Looking over just the last two years, over 4k more CORONA residents are now employed.

The March 2017 CORONA Business Confidence Survey shows 50% of business leaders are expected to increase employment levels over the next 12 months. Only 3% expect to decrease employment levels.
